The National Medical Association owns the copyright for the Journal of the National Medical Association. For permission to photocopy or use material from JNMA please access www.copyright.com or call the Copyright Clearance Center, Inc. (CCC), 978-750-8400. CCC is not-for-profit organization that provides licenses and registration for a variety of users.

Below is a schedule of services and fees.

Academic Permission Service Provides authorization to photocopy material for use in course packs or as handouts for academic courses. 15 cents/page. If students aren't to be charged for the copies or course packs either to cover costs or for profit, there will be no royalty charge.

Annual Authorizations Service Corporations pay a yearly fee to CCC and are then licensed to copy any title in the repertoire for use within the company only. JNMA does not permit this.

Digital Permission Service Provides permission to reproduce copyrighted materials in electronic formats (e.g., email, Internet, intranet or extranet postings). Email: 1-49 recipients- \$2/recipient, 50-249 \$1.50/recipient, 250 + \$1/recipient. Intra/extranet: \$50/30 day posting, \$250/180 day posting, \$400/365 day posting. Internet: \$100/30 day posting, \$500/180 day posting, \$800/365 day posting.

Digital Repertory Service Corporations pay a yearly fee to CCC and are then licensed to share electronically any title in the repertoire for use within the company only. JNMA does not permit this.

Electronic Course Content Service Provides authorization to post copyrighted material on a password protected web site for academic use. 15 cents/page.

Foreign Authorizations Service CCC has entered into agreements with a number of Reproduction Rights Organizations (RRO) and other copyright collectives throughout the world on behalf of U.S. rights holders. CCC is the RRO for the United States. There is no charge to copy or post JNMA articles by those in impoverished countries for educational purposes, subject to the express condition that lawful notice of claim of copyright be given and JNMA is properly cited and a link provided to NMA's website, www.nmanet.org. Otherwise, normal charges mentioned throughout this schedule of services apply.

Republication Licensing Service Provides permission to republish copyrighted material into a variety of formats including books, journals, newsletters, Internet web sites, and CD-ROM. There is a graduated circulation fee beginning at \$ 200.

Republication in Book by JNMA Article Authors NMA grants to authors the royalty free right of republication in any book of which he or she is the author or editor, subject to the express condition that lawful notice of claim of copyright be given.

Transactional Reporting Service Provides permission for individuals and organizations to photocopy material for non-academic use. \$25/copy.
