Born in Albany, GA in 1929, Jarrell attended Howard University, where he received a Master of Fine Arts; Ray Vogue School of Art; and School of the Art Institute of Chicago; and holds a four-year diploma. While in Chicago, Wadsworth contributed his artistic vision to the "Wall of Respect."

Throughout the years, Jarrell's sculptures and paintings have graced more than 130 exhibition halls. His works were featured at the 1996 Olympic Games in Atlanta. Jarrell is an accomplished and innovative artist whose work will continue to be a reputable force in the contemporary art world.
